Eligibility and Guideline for Selection Criteria for Short Term Courses

Eligibility:

1. Teachers/Assistant Librarians/Librarians working in universities that are included under section 2(f) of the UGC Act and of colleges that do not yet come within the provision of section 12(B) but have been affiliated to a university for at least two (2) years may also apply for the STC. Full time contractual/ad-hoc teachers who have been teaching for at least three (3) academic sessions in a college/institution affiliated to a university for at least two (2) years may also apply. NOC from employer must be submitted with application in all cases.

2. **No participant shall be paid Travel Allowance/Dearness Allowance and other allowances for attending courses.**
3. For promotional benefits, subjects/disciplines eligible for different Short Term Courses offered by UGC-HRDC, JU, in the academic session 2018-19, are mentioned hereunder:

* A Short Term Course will be organized only if there are at least 30 eligible applicants. **Preference may be given to reserved category applicants for percentage of seats as mentioned below: SC: 22%, ST: 6%, OBC A: 10%, OBC B: 7%, Differently-abled: 3%.**

Selection Criteria:

Selection of applicants would be made on the basis of their **Score**, which is calculated as the number of days between the Date of next promotion due and the Date of Commencement of the course, and the requirement of the programme concerned for the next stage of promotion.
