If selected in a RC, a candidate has to fulfill all the formalities related to obtain the course completion certificate i.e., participate in the Seminar, Evaluation process, Group discussion and the Assessment work during the course under the guidance of resource persons or course coordinator/s. - b) Seminars/participant presentation
 - c) Project/survey/others
 - d) Micro-teaching/participation
 - e) Holistic response (punctuality, regularity, initiative, conduct, responsiveness, etc.)
2. Selected candidates will have to arrange their own accommodation during their stay in Kolkata for the Programmes.
 3. No. of seats: A Refresher Course will be organized only if there are at least 30 eligible applicants. Maximum number of applicants would generally be 35. However, if need arises, additional 5 seats may be allocated to teachers/scholars (whichever is applicable) of Jadavpur University subject to approval by Director and/or CEO of UGC-HRDC, JU.
