Eligibility and Guideline for Selection Criteria for Refreshers Course

Eligibility:

1. For the Refresher Courses, *participation in the Orientation Programme is a prerequisite* for admission. However, in exceptional cases, a teacher may be allowed to complete a Refresher Course prior to completion of an Orientation Programme.
2. There should be a minimum gap of one year between two courses, though it may be relaxed if adequate number of participants is not available or it is essential for the teacher to fulfil eligibility conditions for career advancement.
3. Teachers/Librarians/Assistant Librarians working in universities that are included under section 2(f) of the UGC Act and teachers/librarians of colleges that do not yet come within the provision of section 12(B) but have been affiliated to a university for at least two (2) years may also apply for Refresher Course. However, they would not be paid Travel Allowance/Dearness Allowance and other allowances for attending courses. Full time contractual/ad-hoc teachers who have been teaching for at least three (3) academic sessions in a college/institution affiliated to a university for at least two (2) years may also apply.
4. For promotional benefits, subjects/disciplines eligible for different Refresher Courses offered by UGC-HRDC, JU, in the academic session 2018-19, are mentioned hereunder:

Selection Criteria:

Selection of applicants would be made on the basis of their **Score**, which is calculated as the number of days between the Date of next promotion due and the Date of Commencement of the course, and the requirement of the programme concerned for the next stage of promotion.
