 - a) Multiple-choice objective tests
 - b) Seminars/participant presentation
 - c) Project/survey/others
 - d) Micro-teaching/participation
 - e) Holistic response (punctuality, regularity, initiative, conduct, responsiveness, etc.)

2. No. of seats: A Refresher Course will be organized only if there are at least 20 eligible applicants. Maximum number of applicants would generally be 35. However, if need arises, additional 5 seats may be allocated to teachers/scholars (whichever is applicable) of Jadavpur University subject to approval by Director and/or CEO of UGC-HRDC, JU.
